

Notes :

(i) The poster should contain the real description of the name of the printer and the distributor or the person who has commissioned the poster.

(ii) No person shall affix or cause to be affixed any poster in a public place other than at a designated site.

(iii) The posters will be removed on the expiry of the **validity period*** (to state number of days)

of the poster and properly disposed of.

(iv) Approval will be subject to availability of space on the panel.

(v) Fees for the fixing of posters (per copy) are as follows

(a) Size - not more than 1 m² - Rs 5.00

(b) Size - more than 1 m² - Rs 50.00

(vi) Any person who fails to comply to any provisions of the Environment Protection (Affixing of Posters) Regulations 2008 or who fails to pay the prescribed fees under Section 102 of The Local Government Act 2003 as subsequently amended, shall commit an offence and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding 50,000 rupees.

(vii) The posters should be submitted for stamping purposes (all posters should bear The seal of The Council)

(viii) The Council will not be liable, in any circumstances, in the event the affixed posters are damaged or removed by vandalsetc. It is also absolved from any claim, damages, suits, actions and proceedings at law of whatever kind and nature.
